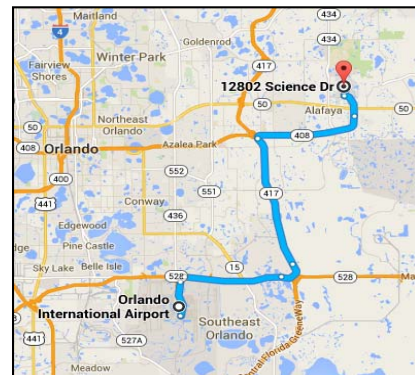

#### **Directions to Carley Corporation from the Orlando International Airport:**

- Take Exit 1A onto Hwy 528 (Beeline toll) East towards Cocoa/Kennedy Space Center
- Then Exit 16 onto Hwy 417 (Greenway toll) towards Tampa/Orlando
- Go North on 417 towards Sanford to Hwy 408 (East-West Expressway toll)
- Take Exit 33A East onto 408 (Towards Titusville) to the end of the expressway (408 transitions into Challenger Parkway)
- Continue onto Challenger Parkway
- Turn Right onto Ingenuity Drive
- Turn Left onto Science Drive
- Carley Corporation will be on the right.



#### **Directions to Carley Corporation from Daytona Beach:**

- Take I-4 West to Hwy 417 South towards Orlando.
- Take Exit 101 B off I-4 West toward International Airports/Sanford to merge onto FL 417.
- Take Exit 37 onto University Blvd
- Keep left at the fork, following signs for University Blvd East
- Turn Left onto University Blvd
- Turn Right onto FL 434 E (Alafaya Trail)
- Turn Left onto Science Drive
- Drive through the first traffic light (Technology Parkway)
- Carley Corporation will be immediately on the right.
